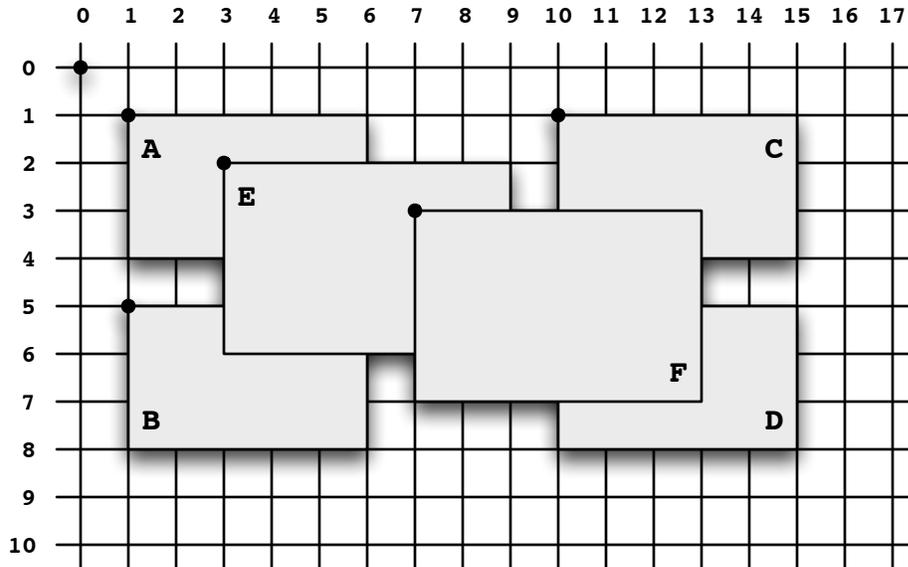


Window manager program: sample window data (for CS 241—Data Structures):



In a Java program, you could declare an array of windows like this:
(assuming you have an appropriate *Window* constructor)

```
Window[] wa = {  
    new Window( "A",    1, 1,  5, 3 ),  
    new Window( "B",    1, 5,  5, 3 ),  
    new Window( "C",   10, 1,  5, 3 ),  
    new Window( "D",   10, 5,  5, 3 ),  
    new Window( "E",    3, 2,  6, 4 ),  
    new Window( "F",    7, 3,  6, 4 )  
};
```

x, y *w, h*

Of course, another (better!) option would be to allow the info to be read in from a file ...

*Seriously, dude?!? It would be **much** better to allow the user to **create** windows with the mouse!*
