

Lab 1: Evaluation (20 pts)

In this lab, each image will be graded on a pass-fail basis (10 pts each, 20 pts total). These are the things to consider:

1. Temple:
 - a) Is there a rendered image on the cs-render drive in the folder `IDS252Sp14/Lab1/FinalImages/your_name?`
 - b) Was color and a ground plane added?
 - c) Is the image 640x480 in size?
 - d) Is the image in jpg or png format?
 - e) Is the image named properly (e.g. “SmithJohn_Lab1_temple.jpg”)
2. Character:
 - a) Is there a rendered image on the cs-render drive in the folder `IDS252Sp14/Lab1/FinalImages/your_name?`
 - b) Is the image 640x480 in size? (or 480x640)
 - c) Is the image in jpg or png format?
 - d) Is the image named properly (e.g. “SmithJohn_Lab1_char.jpg”)
 - e) Was the extra credit done?
3. Are the project folders organized? It is important to develop good habits! We will go over these items in class before you have to hand them in.
 1. Are the project folders appropriately named (e.g. Lab1Temple)?
 2. Are all of the files in the right place?
 3. If there are multiple versions of scenes, is it clear which file is the final one?
 4. Open up the final scene file: Are the items in the outliner grouped and named appropriately (e.g. pCube1 needs renaming!)?
 5. Have unneeded files been deleted from the project folder, especially any files with extension *.iff or with the word “depth” in the name.
